

## 3rd preseason game will be HUGE for Miami

The new staff is installing a new defense and offensive scheme, and they will need to make both key decisions and do a better job of in game adjustments, as that is something we will see more of this week.

In regards to who the starting quarterback will be, I do believe that David Garrard would have been the starting quarterback for the Dolphins, but he had surgery on his knee a little over a week ago and he will not be ready to at least the 1st game of the season. That has opened the door for returning starter Matt Moore and 1st round pick Ryan Tannehill. Ryan had his good moments and bad in the Carolina game, but part of those struggles do have to be given to the poor offensive line play, and the same holds true for Matt Moore. Tannehill did look much better in the 1st preseason game against Tampa Bay backups and Moore has done nothing to separate himself in this race. With that being said, I expect Ryan Tannehill to be the starting quarterback for the Dolphins opening day.

As a fan I try not to put too much into preseason games, as you know the coaches want to see the starters briefly and see a lot of the young kids during the first few preseason games. In this case though, the Dolphins have looked so bad for the most part that as a fan you have to wonder if this team indeed will be the bottom dweller in the AFC East, as most of the so called experts expect the Dolphins to finish.
